

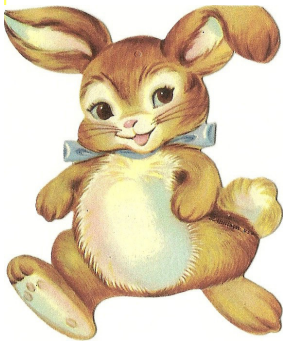
# Step Back Into a 1950s Easter
